

More Export Orders for Middleton Engineering

- *Two more balers off to Scandinavian council*

Glastonbury, 3 September 2012: Local business success Middleton Engineering, the UK's leading baler manufacturer and recycling equipment engineers, has won a third order from Norway's MSX-Maskin AS to supply two additional balers on behalf of a leading Norwegian council. The council will be putting the new balers at the centre of their municipal waste recycling operation at Trondheim, near the Arctic Circle.

Hans Hansen, MSX-Maskin AS who has already supplied Swedish recycling firm Ragn Sells with two Middleton balers said: "I chose these British-made balers because, after having visited the works at Glastonbury and met the engineering team, I am confident that Middletons produces the finest quality machines and employs really good engineers."

The new order is for two Middleton HB60 shear balers adding a further boost to Middleton's export order book. The Norwegian council needed Middletons to modify the capacity of the balers to handle 20 tonnes of newsprint an hour instead of the standard 8 tonnes an hour. Given an engineering challenge, Middletons were quick to oblige and have successfully upgraded the hydraulic systems and motors to deliver the capacity needed.

Ashley Middleton, founder and managing director of Middleton Engineering said: "It's very satisfying for us that such innovative "green" countries like Norway, with their experience in recycling should choose to come to Britain for baling expertise and technology. As a local employer, this is an important endorsement, and it recognises the expertise of the team as well as the design strength and quality of the recycling machinery we are producing."

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
